Then, I try to think like a prospective funder ... what would compel me to jump on board to help? For me, it's like the fun challenge of fitting all the pieces of a puzzle together."

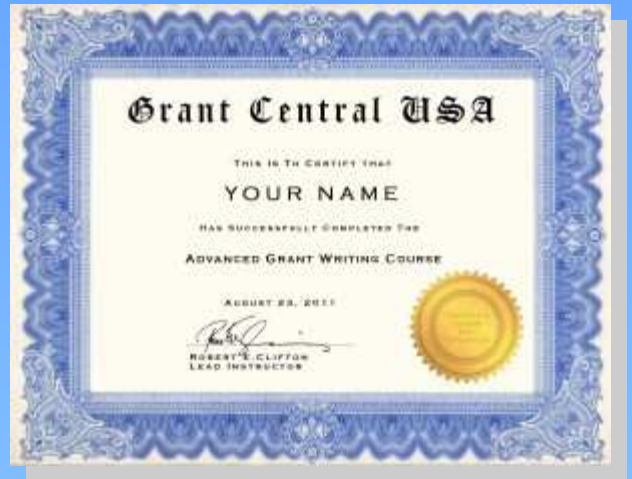
