

[How to Tell if You're Dating a Cheater](#)

1. Are they super jealous?
2. Do they check your phone all the time?
3. Do they always ask where you are and where you're going?
4. Do they tell you long, detailed stories about where they've been when the situation doesn't call for it?*
5. When they walk in the house, do they just start making out with you out of nowhere?*
6. Do they delete messages off their phone or Facebook account?
7. Have you heard from yours or their friends that they're spending a questionably large amount of time with someone from the opposite sex?
8. Do they get VERY defensive when you ask them about if they're cheating or a person you suspect they may have feelings for?***
9. Are they very controlling about the activities you're "allowed" to do?

If you can answer yes to more than one of these questions, unfortunately you're probably dating a cheater.

*Cheaters will often come home late with a big long story about how they ran out of gas and their phone was dead and they had to walk to a gas station and blah blah blah... I used to come up with these stories and tell my boyfriends about them to get them to forgive me for being late and not messaging them or letting them know where I was.
