What are Lice & Nits?

Lice are small grayish/white insects that lay an average of 3-5 eggs (nits) per day. Nits are tiny eggs firmly attached to the hair shaft, usually about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from the scalp.

Head Lice Misconceptions

Head Lice Prevention
