10-DAY VOYAGE ITINERARY

Day 1 • Friday U.S. / LIMA
Fly to Lima, Peru, the nation's capital and largest city. (D Aloft)

Day 2 • Saturday IQUITOS / EMBARK AMAZON RIVERBOAT
Fly to Iquitos and drive to Nauta, where we board our riverboat. Tonight enjoy stargazing and storytelling with our local guides. (B,L,D)

Day 3 • Sunday AMAZON RIVER / RÍO UCAYALI
Enjoy the ever-changing panorama as our ship navigates the Río Ucayali, where we may find gray and pink dolphins. We venture into the rainforest in search of giant water lilies and elusive wildlife. Learn about the lives of the "Ribereño" people as we visit a local village. (B,L,D)

Day 4 • Monday RÍO UCAYALI / PACAYA-SAMIRIA RESERVE
While exploring a small tributary, we search for primates and a variety of birds, along with piranha. Continue upriver to the Pacaya-Samiria Reserve, where we look for monk sakis, red howler and squirrel monkeys. Board skiffs for a chance to find nocturnal wildlife. (B,L,D)

Day 5 • Tuesday PACAYA-SAMIRIA RESERVE
Explore this flooded realm, seeing unique animal and plant life while walking through an *igapo* (seasonally flooded forest). (B,L,D)

Day 6 • Wednesday PACAYA-SAMIRIA RESERVE
Excursion boats grant us deeper access into these vast wetlands. (B,L,D)

Day 7 • Thursday RÍO UCAYALI / RÍO MARAÑÓN
We head downriver, with a wildlife excursion or other activity. After dark, walk in the rainforest and listen to the sounds of the jungle. (B,L,D)

Day 8 • Friday RÍO MARAÑÓN / AMAZON RAINFOREST
Journey into the terra firma forest along a winding trail. Enjoy a festive farewell dinner aboard *La Amatista*. (B,L,D)

Days 9 & 10 • Saturday & Sunday NAUTA / IQUITOS / LIMA / U.S.
Disembark in Nauta and drive to Iquitos. Enjoy a tour of the city, including the Belen market. Fly to Lima and connect with your international flight. Arrive in the U.S. on Sunday. (Day 9: B,L; Day 10: Meals Aloft)

MACHU PICCHU & CUSCO EXTENSION

Machu Picchu, the grandest of all the Inca sites, has some 200 structures, along with brilliant stone masonry. But there is a great deal more to see, and we've included a variety of experiences and time to explore the great city of Cusco and Sacred Valley of the Incas.
