We enable organisations to improve the way they manage, assess and analyse learning, skills, accreditation, competencies and human development through our ReallyManaging® product range and large scale customised systems and solutions.

Recent projects include:

- The first wide scale deployment of iPhones for learning in medical education. The University of Leeds issued smartphones to all fourth and fifth year medical students, giving them access to progress files and assessment modules built by MyKnowledgeMap.
- An online infrastructure for the National Skills Academy for Railway Engineering (NSARE), an organisation established with wide railway industry support to help tackle current and future skills needs within the railway engineering industry. SkillsBackbone, a version of MyKnowledgeMap's ReallyManaging Skills tools, helps NSARE to manage training provision and skills across the sector.
- A range of assessment systems for the Chartered Institute of Personnel and Development (CIPD). The CIPD is Europe's largest HR and development professional body with over 135,000 members. MyKnowledgeMap's ReallyManaging Capability has been used to drive three assessment systems for CIPD for developing people's career plans and personal development objectives. The first tool allows an entire organisation or company to assess itself against CIPD's HR Profession Map whilst the second enables individual CIPD members to explore the HR Profession Map and assess themselves against it. The third tool is used as part of the CIPD membership application process.
