

PERCEPTIVE SOFTWARE HQ, LENEXA CITY CENTER – FACT SHEET

- Two buildings plus connecting atrium – approx. 240K sq. ft.
- The buildings and land will be owned by Perceptive Software, LLC
- Architect - Klover Architects, Overland Park, KS
- General Contractor - J.E. Dunn Construction Company, Kansas City, MO
- Approximately 13.4 acres
- More than twice the size of existing headquarters
- Each building will be four stories tall
- Atrium with abundant glass and natural-light with internal bridges connecting the two buildings
- Buildings will be designed and built to LEED standards and the company will be applying for LEED certification
- A dodge ball court that will allow the company to continue to host its annual “Dodge For a Cause” tournament, a fundraiser for the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF), the leading global organization focused on type 1 diabetes. Last year, the tournament raised over \$20,000 in support of JDRF;
- The original Perceptive Software slide, which will be moved from the current facility
- Café with variety of healthy food options
- Recessed parking deck to not block exterior views from the buildings
- Access to future Lenexa walking/biking trail
- Expected completion date – Spring 2014
