To ensure our program continues to reach organizations with the most serious needs, we have established the following guidelines to evaluate Contributions Applications.

Program Guidelines

Program Focus

Parks, historic sites and museums whose programs are enhanced by their trees will receive priority consideration. Additionally, preference will be given to trees posing a safety hazard and older trees that have an historical or environmental significance. An organization must be able to demonstrate that the tree(s) would not be preserved without help from Giroud.

Eligible Organizations

We welcome applications from any 501(c) 3 organization that is open to the entire community on a nonsectarian basis.

Geographic Location

An organization must be located within Giroud's service area of Montgomery, Bucks and Philadelphia Counties.
