The LINQ plugs into the diagnostic port under the dash. Installation takes seconds and requires no tools!

- Measure vehicle acceleration (requires web connection)

Our TrailDash tuner for Jeep offers an innovative and unique Crawl Tune. The exclusive tuning provides Jeep owners, hitting the trails, with better bottom end torque and a softer pedal to aid in climbing obstacles, such as rocks or steep inclines, where a steady pedal and the right amount of power is needed to get you through.

TECH TIP OF THE MONTH

Q: I'm taking my vehicle to the service center for routine maintenance. I don't want to return it to stock. They told me it is okay. Am I safe leaving the tuning in the vehicle?

A: Superchips highly recommends that you return the vehicle to stock. Even taking the vehicle in for an oil change can result in a technical service bulletin (TSB) being performed. If this TSB involves reflashing a new calibration into the vehicles computer (PCM) then it will lock out the tuner and require an "unlock" to be performed so that it can be used again. Unlocks typically cost \$100 but we can waive this fee if you can provide us a copy of your receipt showing us you had the vehicle serviced.
