We have decided to do everything we can to help by sacrificing just about anything to save them and provide a home where they can grow, thrive, and live without fear of misrepresentation and judgment. 


Our First Steps

To start our journey we first have to raise money for our rescue. This includes the most important step of finding the land, getting the soil ready for building, pouring concrete, and making sure we have wells dug and working so we have water for the wolves. (They love to play in the water as well as drink it!) The pictures below show the properties we think are best suited for the wolves, and the type of enclosures we will erect which will all include small wading pools, climbing toys and platforms, and manmade dens. They will be a minimum of 8ft with returns as shown because they do love to jump and the returns will discourage climbing.



A barn structure will act as our office/storage/garage/and indoor enclosure pens. We plan to have enclosures for healing (as if from a surgery or spay or neuter), quarantine pens before joining the outside wolves (for all new rescues), and vet rooms for visits and checkups.

MYTH: Wolves kill people.


FACT: In 100 years in the U.S. only one person was killed by a DNA confirmed wolf pack and this was in a remote town in Alaska.
