

"Cancer can't stop princesses!" says Jamaya Johnson age 14. In October 2011 Jamaya was diagnosed with Hodgkins Lymphoma and after being in remission twice her cancer is now back for a third time. For the last two years Jamaya has had hundreds of medical appointments and hasn't even been healthy enough to attend school. She desperately needs a marrow cell transplant to save her life. Like most patients Jamaya does not have a match in her family and must rely on an unrelated donor. Jamaya is most likely to match an African American donor but right now only 7% of registry members are African American. This makes it even harder for patients like Jamaya to find a match.
