Finn previously participated in a surface transportation summit at the White House regarding toll roads and public-private partnerships. Invited by the U.S. Department of Transportation to express the engineering community's point of view, he was one of 10 panelists selected to educate U.S. legislators about innovative financing techniques.

Hot lanes, tolling interoperability and new toll legislation are changing the way states generate transportation revenue. Finn has testified before Congress, met with numerous governors and mayors and has been quoted by news organizations across the country, including ABC News, Engineering News-Record and USA Today.

- Relationships with transportation leaders across the country. Finn serves as an advisory board member (as part of HNTB's general engineering consultant contracts) with the North Carolina Turnpike Authority, the Tampa-Hillsborough County Expressway Authority, the Miami-Dade County Expressway Authority, and the New Jersey, Massachusetts, Maine and Ohio Turnpike Authorities.
- Wealth of tolling knowledge. For instance, he led the New Jersey Turnpike's \$2.8 billion widening program in the mid-1980s and more recently helped NJTA sell more than \$1 billion in Build America Bonds to fund its \$7 billion capital program. He also has worked with several major toll authorities and managed numerous complex toll road projects in the U.S.

In addition to answering questions about technical and transportation planning and financing techniques, Finn can discuss a variety of industry trends, including:

• Economy takes a 'toll' on states – Due to eroding gas tax revenues, rising costs and America's crumbling infrastructure, an

- increasing number of states are turning to tolling as an innovative funding option.
- Toll technology calls motorists to the open road – The toll industry is accelerating into a new age. Technological advancements are making tolling a more acceptable option for motorists and opening up vast value pricing opportunities, including congestion pricing and high-occupancy toll lanes.
- Public-private partnerships are one promising funding innovation P3s are allowing transportation agencies to leverage private technical, management and financial resources to achieve public objectives, such as greater cost and schedule certainty, supplementing in-house staff, innovative technology applications, specialized expertise and access to private capital.
