- **Buffalo Bill Historical Center (BBHC):** a museum complex begun in 1927 to celebrate the West; its focus is western history, firearms, western art, natural history of Yellowstone region, and Plains Indian history and culture
- **Cody, Wyoming:** founded by William F. “Buffalo Bill” Cody; lies 50 miles east of Yellowstone
- **William F. Cody (1846 – 1917):** a man who lived the Old West with buffalo hunting, Pony Express, his Wild West arena show, and an entrepreneur who founded Cody, WY
- **Yellowstone National Park:** America’s first national park founded in 1872; located in northwest Wyoming
- **Bruce Eldredge:** BBHC Executive Director
- **Dr. Charles R. Preston:** Founding Curator, Draper Museum of Natural History
