- Buffalo Bill Historical Center (BBHC): a museum complex begun in 1927 to celebrate the West; its focus is western history, firearms, western art, nature and science of the Yellowstone region, and Plains Indian history and culture
- Cody, Wyoming: founded by William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody; lies 50 miles east of Yellowstone
- William F. Cody (1846 1917): a man who lived the Old West with buffalo hunting, Pony Express, his Wild West arena show, and an entrepreneur who founded Cody, Wyoming
- Draper Museum of Natural History: opened in 2002 at the BBHC
- Yellowstone National Park: America's first national park founded in 1872; located in northwest Wyoming
- Bruce Eldredge: BBHC Executive Director
- Dr. Charles R. Preston: Senior and Founding Curator, Draper Museum of Natural History
- Melissa Hill: Draper Museum of Natural History Assistant Curator for the Greater Yellowstone Raptor Experience
