Program Details

The EIM Institute of Managerial Leadership is a 12-month program of post-professional education, broadly applicable to everyone from a recent graduate who wants to be considered for a leadership role to an experienced clinician running a hospital department.

The Learning Experience

The majority of the program happens wherever you happen to be, providing the flexibility to have a life while working, furthering your education, and developing lifelong relationships with faculty and fellow students. There is no need to move or change jobs to participate.

The EIM Institute of Managerial Leadership combines didactic and collaborative education experiences using a blend of distance learning, online and on-site courses. Online coursework requires 4-6 hours per week, whenever it is convenient for you. Additionally, there are three intensive on-site weekend experiences required at the beginning, middle, and end of the 12-month program. There is no busy work, as all coursework is directly applicable back to your daily responsibilities.

Those already in leadership roles will be transformed from good managers to exceptional leaders. Admission Requirements

- 1. All students accepted into the Program must be a PT/OT/SLP or employed by a PT/OT/SPL or PT/OT/SLP Department (e.g. business manager) who has successfully completed an accredited professional therapy curriculum. Administrative staff of therapy practices/departments are welcome.
- 2. tDPT students must be a PT with a current license to practice physical therapy. This license must not be under suspension, revocation, probationary status, or subject to disciplinary proceedings or inquiry.

Application Process

Cohorts begin every September, however, clinical courses for the tDPT option are offered throughout the year and can be taken before, during or after the management/ leadership course work.
