WELCOME! We are thrilled to have you compete with us during our Bluemont BBQ Bash. This is our third year and each year it gets better and better as we take advice from our competitors and judges. Here are a couple things to bring to your attention for this year's competition.

Here is the link to the 2012 KCBS Rules & Regulations in case you have not already read them over. http://www.kcbs.us/pdf/2012\_Rules.pdf . 2013 has not been updated on KCBS web yet.

There is at least \$5,000 in **prize money** for the competition this year. We will provide a break down closer to the date.

The **People's Choice Award** is mandatory, but if you don't have room on your grill you can opt out for \$150. We will provide each competitor 2x 9lb bone out Pork Butts to cook, pull, and place in one of our provided pans to be turned in by 11am. We want to make this process as easy as possible for you all as you are helping us make our customers happy by giving them a chance to try the real stuff! This is how we can keep this event a successful one. We ask that you turn in your pans, but we will have a volunteer serve so you can focus on the KCBS competition. How will it be judged? Each paying customer will receive 5 tickets to in which they will be assigned certain blind (competitor not advertised) pork pans and receive a 1oz cup to taste per ticket. They will give a token to the volunteer to their favorite pork and the competitor with the most tokens wins! A large portion (if not all) of the proceeds will go to Loudoun Interfaith to help feed our community. There will be a health inspector on site and we will provide a wash station and rubber gloves when handling this meat if there are any questions, but it is covered under Great Country Farms so you do not have to get a license. If you decide last minute not to participate we will have to charge you \$150 as we have presold the tickets.

The **Dessert Competition** is a Blackberry Bonanza theme. You must use Blackberries as a main ingredient. This dessert can be made prior event. We will be selling Blackberries at this time if you would like to use Great Country Farms! It must be served open platter with a maximum dimension of 12"x18"x18"H, about the size of a half cookie sheet. This will be judged by our VIP Judges, not the KCBS Judges.

The **Waiters Race** will be right after the dessert category in which someone from your team is allowed to compete through an obstacle course with a tray and a wine glass of water. The first through the course without spilling their glass wins.

You must arrive between 9:00am and 3:00pm on Friday for **check-in and meat inspection**. We cannot accommodate you on Thursday. You are welcome to stay Saturday night until Sunday at 10am.

We can offer an **electric hookup** at an additional rate or you are welcome to bring in your own generator. The first year we didn't offer electric, the second year we offered it for free, the third year we are meeting in the middle. We learn as we go!

We have a **water spigot** for you to use temporarily (not a permanent hookup). We will also have someone driving around to fill up your water when needed.

There will be a place for trash, ash and grease disposal Saturday evening.

We will **provide 2 bag of ice**. Additional bags can be purchased \$2/10lb bag.



Each competitor only gets **6 passes** for the festival, which are the names listed on your application. Other family members will have to pay admission to attend the event.

Friday Night we will have **free Wine tasting** for your 6 competitors and any paid family members.

We will be putting together an **Event Program** to feature all of our competitors. Here is an example from last year 2012 Event Program. If you can send us a 150 word max description about your team and your current KCBS Ranking then our guests can get the chance to learn about you all. Some topics to think about is how you started up your team, about your sauces and how you cook your meat, how long you have been cooking and if it is a family recipe, or even neat events you cooked for. If you have a logo that you would like us to add next to your description or a small photo we can see if we can fit it in.
