SESSION FEES INCLUDE: Laundry service, transportation by bus to and from camp, all meals, lodging, weekly field trip admissions and a Camp Yofi t-shirt.

DEPOSIT AND REFUND POLICY: A non-refundable \$300 per camper deposit plus a non-refundable \$75 registration fee is due with your completed Camp Yofi application. The balance of all your camp fees is due by June 1, 2013. All remaining balances will be automatically charged or another form of payment must be submitted by June 1, 2013. All registrations received after June 1, 2013 must be paid in full. All camper paperwork is due June 1, 2013.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Canteen Fee: A \$25 per week per camper canteen fee is due with your deposit. This fee will be put towards your camper's account so they will be able to receive an item at the camp's canteen daily during their stay.

Field Trip Account: A \$10 per week per camper field trip account deposit will be added to your balance due Each week your camper will receive \$10 spending money while on the planned outing. The field trip account is not used for admissions for the event.

DISCOUNTS

JCC Membership Discounts: Any campers outside of Orange County who are currently members of their local JCC are eligible for the Camp Yofi member discounts

Sibling Discount: Families enrolling more than one camper for the 2013 camping season will receive \$100 discount towards the second sibling's enrollment, \$200 discount towards the third sibling's enrollment and \$400 discount towards the fourth sibling's enrollment.

Super Camper Discount: Campers who register for four (4) weeks at Camp Yofi will receive an additional 5% discount. This discount is not valid for the CIT or the Leadership program.

K'Far Noar offers campers a perfect combination of both camp and special activities. Campers are placed in small group environments to help them develop interpersonal


CHAVURAH Entering 7th-8th Grade
