Case Study Rackspace



Goal:

To create a Windows 8 application that can be used on PCs and tablets to provide access to the Rackspace Cloud powered by OpenStack and allow management and administration of a customer's account.

Business Challenge:

Rackspace is the service leader in cloud computing. The company delivers enterprise-level hosting services to businesses of all sizes and kinds around the world. It started in 1998 and since has grown to serve more than 190,000 customers. Rackspace integrates the industry best technologies for each customer's specific need and is strongly committed to fanatical support.

As Rackspace was getting ready to launch Windows Server 2012 in the Cloud, it was necessary to get a Windows 8 application developed that could have a Windows 8 style UI and engage with the Cloud Servers located in Rackspace's open Cloud.

Rackspace was working against the clock and chose Making Sense as their partner to create the Rackspace Cloud for Windows 8 application. Rackspace was absolutely convinced that in order to develop a responsive custom application it was first necessary to team with a creative company experienced in developing Windows 8 apps.

The Solution:

Results-oriented and with a team of highly qualified professionals passionate for delivering quality projects Making Sense completed the project in less than 5 weeks on budget and on time. Rackspace's main goal was to enable an entire new experience for its customers and to give them the possibility to choose how to access their Rackspace account. Making Sense developed a custom application built for a Windows 8 style interface, putting focus on the User Experience to be provided by the application to Rackspace customers.
