While various events will take place throughout the entire month, the majority of events will take place between April 21 and April 27, 2013.

Live music will be heard throughout Downtown Napa during the whole month. Some of the music events include the following:

- Every Wednesday night in April at Andaz Napa visitors have an opportunity to enjoy live music from 6 9 p.m.
- Live in the Vineyard: XI will take place April 5 April 7, 2013, highlighting music, food and wine. Live music will be
 performed regularly at <u>Uptown Theatre Napa</u>. Wine tasting and one-on-one culinary tips with local chefs will also be part
 of the event. Greg Cole of <u>Celadon</u> and Ken Frank of <u>La Toque</u> are some of the chefs participating.

Businesses along Napa's Riverfront will be hosting an event titled "Chalk it Up," along with local artist Amy Hall and New Tech High School, on April 21, 2013 from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. Hall will be creating a unique nine foot by 12 foot chalk drawing throughout the day. Additionally, New Tech High School students will create various chalk drawings on four foot by eight foot MDO Board. The drawings will be sold and all proceeds will be donated to New Tech High School. Similarly, students will be hosting an art booth where they will be selling chalk art sets for children. Proceeds for the art sets will also be donated to New Tech High School.

Launching April 24, 2013, the Downtown Napa Association will host DoNapa Wednesdays, as various businesses in Downtown Napa will feature a variety of specials.
