Each resort is within 100 miles or so of Denver and offers a plethora of amenities and services to fit the lifestyles of all guests.

April 5 celebrates the start of the 20<sup>th</sup> season for the Colorado Rockies. Coors Field welcomes the team and its fans with plenty of special giveaways such as magnet schedules, Rockies t-shirts, commemorative photos, bobble heads and lunch cooler bags. The Major League Baseball franchise hopes to better its 2012 fifth-place finish in the National League West and head to the World Series for its first-ever championship title.

Visitors to the Mile High City also can explore more than two-dozen must-see attractions during their stay at the hotel near Colorado Rockies baseball. Among the options are:

- Smelling the flowers at Denver Botanic Gardens. The 23-acre oasis in the middle of the city has 33,000 plans in 45 gardens.
- Tasting the Rockies at the Coors Brewery. Free tours walk guests through every step of the brewing process, with free samples for those over 21 years old.
- Hiking in Rocky Mountain National Park. Colorado’s No. 1 attraction features more than 30 miles of trails with wildflowers, waterfalls, lakes and peaks.

No matter how visitors choose to spend their time while in Denver, they will always find plush accommodations to return to at the Denver Tech Center hotel. Rooms with one king or two double beds provide the comforts of home for a sound night’s slumber.
