

Who's Who - What's What

- Buffalo Bill Historical Center (soon to be Buffalo Bill Center of the West): a museum complex begun in 1927 to celebrate the West; its focus is western history, firearms, western art, nature and science of Yellowstone, and Plains Indian history and culture
- Cody, Wyoming: founded by William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody; lies 50 miles east of Yellowstone
- William F. Cody (1846 1917): a man who lived the Old West with buffalo hunting, Pony Express, his Wild West arena show, and an entrepreneur who founded Cody, WY
- Whitney Gallery of Western Art: the western art museum of the Buffalo Bill Center of the West
- Yellowstone National Park: America's first national park founded in 1872; located in northwest Wyoming
- Bruce Eldredge: Executive Director
- Mindy Besaw: Curator of the Whitney Gallery of Western Art
- Marguerite House: Acting Public Relations Manager
