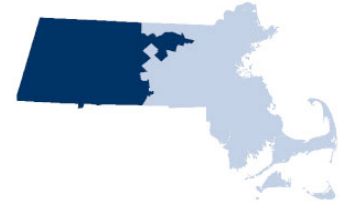

DSCI Connects to the Newly Lit MassBroadband 123 Network

April 9, 2013 -- Waltham, MA -- If you're in western Massachusetts, fasten your seat belt... because your business is about to pick up some serious speed.

Last week, Massachusetts Governor Deval Patrick officially lit up [the first segment of the MassBroadband 123 network](#): 51 community anchor institutions stretching from Springfield to Sandisfield. When the project is completed later this year, 1,200 miles of fiber-optic cable will connect 120 communities in western and north central Massachusetts - a region that's currently underserved in terms of broadband connectivity.



Meanwhile, DSCI Corporation secured its role in this remarkable transformation by signing a connection agreement with [Axia NGNetworks USA](#), operator of the MassBroadband 123 network. This agreement fulfills a [letter of intent](#) that DSCI signed with Axia in May 2012.

The newly-established network interconnection enables DSCI to more cost-effectively deliver its business-class telecommunications services to businesses and organizations throughout western Massachusetts. DSCI's services include hosted VoIP (voice over IP), video calling, unified messaging, audio and web conferencing, private networking, and high-speed Internet access.

No one should have to settle for the dated technology that's been prevalent in the area," commented Sean Dandley, DSCI's President and CEO.
