Assessment

1. Following completion of the Masterclasses, you will attend a 2-3 hour assessed interview. This is an oral evaluation which determines your competence by mapping your knowledge, skills and experience against the National Occupational Standards of Competence. The interview is conducted by a senior member of the ICA Assessment Board.

Grading of the assessment is on a competent/non competent basis.

Throughout the duration of the programme it is recommended that you build a portfolio that demonstrates work-based competence. This can consist of policies, reports, guides, plans, evaluations, articles, blogs, conference papers, etc.

- 2. You will also be required to write a 2-3 page summary of four of the Masterclasses, which:
 - Summarise the key issues and identifies relevant risks to your organisation
 - Evaluates the benefits of suggested solutions for your organisation

These will be produced at the assessment interview as evidence of competency but will not be specifically graded.

National Occupational Standards of Competence

Your performance on the programme will be measured, against the National Occupational Standards of Competence (2011 version) produced originally by the Financial Services Skills Council (FSSC) and the ICA and revised recently by the Financial Skills Partnership.

The Standards are statements of competence which articulate the requirements for effective performance in the workplace. Competence is defined as a combination of skills as well as knowledge and understanding.

Masterclass Titles

- Possess an ICA Diploma and five years experience in a financial services or similar discipline and currently work within a job role that requires senior level responsibilities or, where currently not in such a role, you have the potential and experience to do so
