

SECONDS

A backup system that runs simultaneously with the primary system. Data is typically replicated in real time and both systems host identical data.

HOURS

A backup system is available and is a close mimic of the primary system. Data is replicated more often than a cold standby, but again at the discretion of the client. There can be times when both servers don't contain the same data.

DAYS

A backup system is available if the primary system fails. This is usually used for non-critical information and scheduled backups would be customized by the client.



Not having a Disaster Recovery plan can be catastrophic for your company. 80% of companies that experience a significant data loss are out of business within one month.


DISASTROUS STATISTICS
