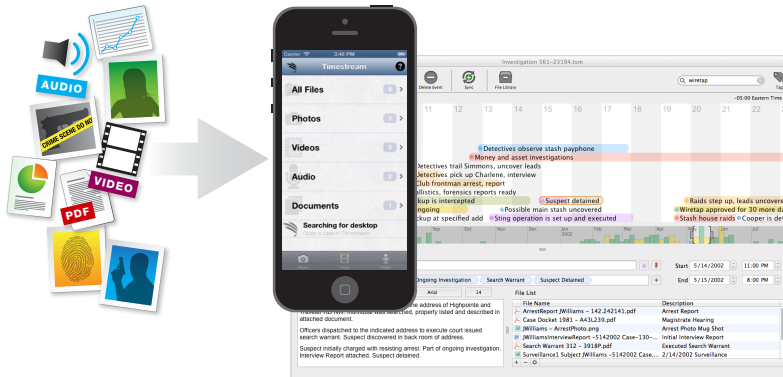
A New Approach to Case Analysis and Presentation

Organizing, analyzing and sharing information during the course of an investigation can be challenging. Evidence photos, videos, recorded interviews and documents from a variety of sources in different formats are continuously added during the lifecycle of a case, making it difficult to stay organized and assess the chronology of events.

Ntrepid Timestream takes a new approach, where the focus is on the sequence of events, corroborated by collected evidence.

Collect Evidence

Use *Timestream* in the field to collect corroborating digital evidence using your iPhone. Send directly to *Timestream*, where a digital hash verifies authenticity and establishes chain of custody.



Visualize & Analyze

Plot events chronologically on a timeline to analyze or explain case facts, using filters to hone in on certain points in time or specific persons of interest.

How it Works
