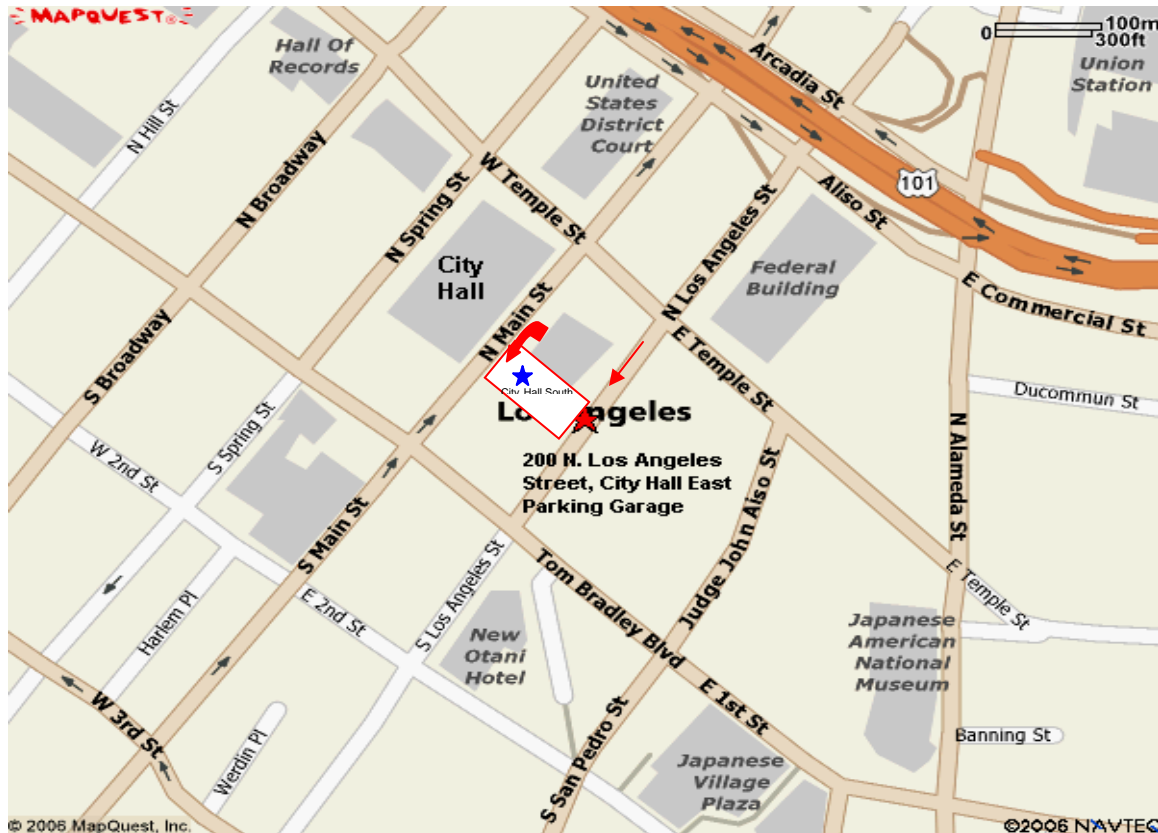

PARKING INFORMATION

If you would like to request parking, please provide your car's make, model and license plate number (ex. Ford Explorer, Lic. Plate: ABC1234) when you RSVP at SP-RSVP@LACITY.ORG.

The City Hall East parking garage (**Red star on the map**) is located at 200 N. Los Angeles St, LA 90012 on the west side of Los Angeles St. between Temple & 1st across the street from Parker Center.



DIRECTIONS FROM THE PARKING LOT TO THE SOUTH PLAZA (Blue star on the Map)

Park in the "Visitor's Section" of P2. Head south toward the white vans and city cars parked inside a fence. Follow the walkway to a door with a large sign that reminds city employees to have their ID badges visible at all times. Enter the door and take either bank of elevators to the 2nd floor.

Exit the elevator, turn west toward Main Street and go through the glass doors. Turn left (towards Tom Bradley Blvd/ 1st Street) and you will see the entrance to South Plaza up the stairs in front of you. Go to the Registration table.
