

Being exposed to broken relationships, suffering abandoned love, finding out a romance was just an illusion, spiritual growth and the death of love ones through illness are all part of life's sequence; some might say they're adventures. Past memories, self esteem, frozen childhood wounds and my search for my longings have all influenced this anthology, my creative outlet.

However, there are funny sides - laughter filled with smiles that move through the yesteryears where the vivid past embraces new adventure of joy.
