Throughout these travels, Louis-Philippe had a difficult time finding trusted sources for bus travel information. Online research often led him to outdated bus company sites in a foreign language. In-person experiences at bus terminals were similarly frustrating.

"There must be an easier way to find accurate bus information when you travel." This was the inspiration for Busbud.

Recruiting two childhood friends, technical co-founders Frederic Thouin and Michael Gradek, he embarked on the mission to make life easier for bus travelers around the world.

Launched in November 2011, Busbud is privately funded by angel investors and proudly based in Montreal, Canada.
