Once the project was underway, construction for the Taos Charter School was completed in just over seven months. Funding for the project came from several sources, including public school construction funds, a band loan arranged by the Friends of Taos Charter School, dozens of private donations and a generous land donation.

The large size of each building and the land donor's architectural covenants led the design team to incorporate buttresses and stepped parapet walls to provide relief. The buildings are set on a concrete foundation and feature natural lighting throughout with multiple skylights.

The buildings provide Taos Charter School with a variety of teaching spaces, including: classrooms, a science lab, a music/art/lunch area, a library and storage areas. Administrative areas include a reception area, offices and a nurses office.
