## OnRamp Founder to Sit on Hybrid Hosting Panel Discussion at HostingCon 2013

Kissinger will be joining a group of industry-leading professionals to discuss "The Coming Hybrid Wave: Colocation and the Cloud" on Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am. Kissinger's discussion will kickoff Tuesday's educational content for the Technology Track and will highlight the benefits of merging <u>colocation</u> and the cloud to create hybrid solutions designed to effectively manage a business's IT operations.

ReadyServer solutions solve the challenge of needing to quickly obtain and provision a new or spare server on-demand, in an emergency.
