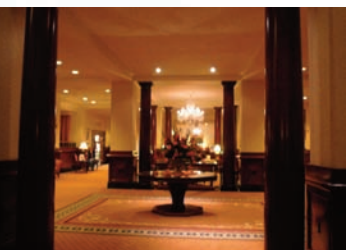
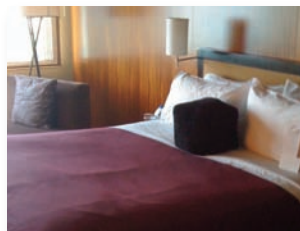


BRECKENRIDGE, CO – Townhouse/hotel accommodations

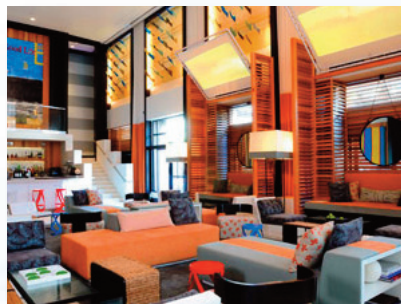


WASHINGTON, D.C. – Capital Hilton
