# 15 About Hepatitis A Virus

5.

16 8. *Hepatitis A* (formerly known as *infectious hepatitis*) is an acute infectious disease of 17 the liver caused by the *hepatitis A* virus (*HAV*), a virus usually spread by the fecal-oral route, with 18 infection often being traced to conditions of poor sanitation. In addition, the *HAV* virus is highly 19 resilient, and is resistant to detergent, acid (pH 1), solvents (e.g., ether, chloroform), drying, and 20 temperatures up to 60 °C. It can survive for months in fresh and salt water, as well as in frozen 21 products.

9. Following ingestion, *HAV* enters the bloodstream through the epithelium of the oropharynx, or intestine. The blood carries the virus to its target, the liver, where it multiplies within hepatocytes and Kupffer cells. As a result, virions are secreted into the bile and released in stool. *HAV* is excreted in large quantities approximately 11 days prior to appearance of symptoms or anti-*HAV* IgM antibodies in the blood. The incubation period is 15–50 days, with a mortality rate of one-in-two hundred.

1 10. It is an acute illness, which means that the symptoms can come on suddenly and 2 sharply, causing a range of clinical problems from mild illness with no symptoms to more severe 3 illness. Typical symptoms include fatigue, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain or discomfort (especially 4 in the area of the liver beneath the lower ribs on the right side), loss of appetite, low-grade fever, dark 5 urine, muscle pain, and yellowing of the skin and eyes (jaundice). But *HAV* is also one of several 6 types of hepatitis viruses that can cause inflammation that affects a liver's ability to function, and in 7 some cases can cause liver failure, chronic liver disease, or even death.

## 8 The HAV Outbreak

9 11. On May 31, 2013, U.S Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") announced 10 that it was collaborating with public health officials in several states and the U.S. Food and Drug 11 Administration ("FDA") to investigate a multistate outbreak of at least 30 *Hepatitis A* Virus (*HAV*) 12 infections. According to the CDC, the first outbreak infection presented with symptoms of *HAV* on 13 April 29th. And while the victims have all been adults, this *HAV* outbreak has disproportionately 14 affected women (65% of those identified).

15 12. So far, there have been at least 9 hospitalizations of the 30 cases identified, or over 30% 16 of all reported cases. Given the significant lag time between infection and reporting (incubation 17 periods range from two weeks to seven weeks) many more infections are likely to be identified in the 18 coming months.

In the course of its investigation, the CDC has traced the *HAV* infections to
 consumption of Townsend Farms Organic Anti-Oxidant Blend frozen berries sold throughout the
 Western United States. Among the 30 *Hepatitis A* victims identified so far, residents have been
 identified in the following states and counties: California (Humboldt, Orange, Riverside, San
 Bernardino, and San Diego Counties), New Mexico (Bernalillo County), Arizona (Maricopa County),
 Colorado (Adams, Boulder, Clear Creek, Eagle and Jefferson Counties) and Nevada (Washoe and
 Clark Counties).

14. According to the CDC, initial laboratory studies of specimens from two HAV virus
victims have been isolated, being identified as genotype 1B, a strain rarely seen in the Americas but
which circulates in North Africa and the Middle East.

Also according to the CDC, two recent outbreaks of HAV in Europe in 2013 and in 2 15. British Columbia in 2012, were also linked to frozen berries. In the British Columbia outbreak, the 3 infection was traced to pomegranate seeds from Egypt. In the current outbreak, Townsend Farms 4 frozen berry mix contains pomegranate seeds from Turkey. 5

6 **Plaintiff's Hepatitis A Illness** 

7 16. Plaintiff purchased Defendants' frozen fruit blend at a nearby Costco retail 8 establishment in Lakewood, California. On or about May 22, she began to experience fatigue, chills, 9 muscle and joint aches, and loss of appetite. Over the next few days, she began to experience 10 additional symptoms, including vomiting and dry heaves, darkened urine, and yellowing of the eyes and skin. She was taken to her local doctor's office where she submitted blood and urine samples and 11 12 was given IV fluids for dehydration.

17. 13 On May 30, her doctors informed her that her liver enzymes were severely elevated, and she was immediately scheduled for an ultrasound later that day. On May 31, after her test results 14 showed severe liver inflammation, she was admitted to Long Beach Memorial Hospital for continued 15 16 IV therapy, anti-nausea medication, testing, and monitoring.

18. On June 1, her hepatologist informed her that she had contracted Hepatitis A, and that 18 she would need to be isolated from other patients.

19 19. Ms. Brackenridge remains hospitalized in isolation at Long Beach Memorial Hospital in guarded condition. 20

21 20. Prior to her Hepatitis A illness, Ms. Brackenridge led an otherwise healthy, active 22 lifestyle, which included hiking, kayaking, climbing, and other rigorous outdoor activities.

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

# (Strict Products Liability)

21. Plaintiff hereby incorporates paragraphs 1 through 20 above.

26 22. At all times, Defendants were in the business of importing, manufacturing, distributing, 27 and marketing its frozen fruit mix product ("fruit mix").

28

#### **COMPLAINT FOR DAMAGES**

1 23. There was a manufacturing defect in the fruit mix when it left Defendants' possession 2 and control. The fruit mix was defective because it contained *HAV*. The presence of *HAV* was a 3 condition of the product that rendered it unreasonably dangerous.

4 24. There was a marketing defect in the fruit mix when it left Defendants' possession and 5 control. The fruit mix was defective because it contained *HAV* and Defendants failed to give adequate 6 warnings of the product's dangers that were known or by the application of reasonably developed 7 human skill and foresight should have been known. Defendants also failed to give adequate warnings 8 and instructions to avoid such dangers. Defendants' failure to provide such warnings and instructions 9 rendered the fruit mix unreasonably dangerous.

10 25. Defendants' conduct was a direct, proximate, and producing cause of Plaintiff's injuries
11 and damages set forth below.

12 26. Defendants are therefore strictly liable for importing, manufacturing, distributing,
13 marketing, and selling defective and unreasonably dangerous fruit mix and introducing it into the
14 stream of commerce.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

(Negligence)

27. Plaintiff hereby incorporates paragraphs 1 through 26 above.

28. Defendants owed Plaintiff a duty of ordinary care in the manufacture, preparation,
testing, packaging, marketing, distribution, and selling of the fruit mix in question. Further,
Defendants owed Plaintiff the duty of warning or instructing Plaintiff of potentially hazardous or lifethreatening conditions with respect to the fruit mix.
