 automatically populate feedback to the student, if desired. The student can view their individual
 scores and feedback per assignment by clicking on the "View Rubric" link within the Grades Tab.
- Instructors can now open and grade completed assignments using the rubric both from the Gradebook and the Dropbox Tool, saving the faculty time.
- Point values for each rubric level may be set by default, but can also be overridden in each criterion by the instructors for added flexibility in grading each criterion.
- Grading is accomplished by one click.
- The design of the rubric tool has been updated for easier readability and use.
