NAPLES, FLORIDA | June 27, 2013—Lutheran Life Communities has announced that it has exceeded its presales goal for The Arlington of Naples, the new luxury resort-style Continuing Care Retirement Community planned for development in Naples' award-winning Lely Resort. The Arlington of Naples is the first completely new Continuing Care Retirement Community to be built in the Naples and Marco Island area in many years. The community will offer Independent Living in villas and apartments as well as Assisted Living, Skilled Nursing and Memory Support.
