To help upgrade its information systems and manage projected growth, Rochester College turned to Three Rivers Systems' CAMS Windows in 1997 and later upgraded to CAMS Enterprise in 2008.

According to Rochester College Registrar

Rebekah Pinchback, CAMS Enterprise was being used campus-wide but some modules and functions were not being utilized, including online registration. She proposed a plan for taking registration and course evaluations online, making a strong case for efficiency as well as cost savings. Her project was given the "green light" right away.

"Learning how to use online registration functions in CAMS was easy," she said. All told, implementation took about six months. "We had to reorganize and change our advising policies, train advisors and staff members to use the system, do beta testing and launch a marketing campaign to get students excited about the new process," Pinchback said.

"We have been registering online, now, for two years and it has made a world of difference in our community and freed up a tremendous amount of time in my office. I can't even imagine doing paper registrations, again!" Course evaluations at RC used to take weeks to run paper surveys through a Scantron[®] machine and then tally them in Excel.





"We would be halfway into the next semester before instructors received results," Pinchback said. "Now, it takes us a couple of hours to distribute evaluations to individual instructors and department heads can access them through CAMS at any time. It's a beautiful thing!"

Pinchback said the conversion to online registration ignited a revolution on campus to look at CAMS, differently, and to start exploring the possibilities. "Soon after online registration, we dug deep into student and faculty portals. Today, we are doing even greater portal customization and have moved all of our applications to an application portal. Our financial aid and business offices have made tremendous strides in getting all of their information online, and my office continues to seek out areas for process improvement in the areas of degree audit and graduation."
