This specialized program helps bridge the discharge from hospital to home. With our coaching, patients go from being cared for to safely caring for themselves.

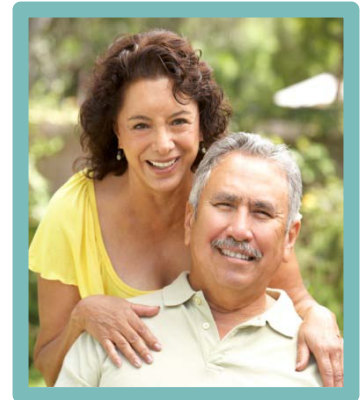

caregiver to take an active role in their healthcare.

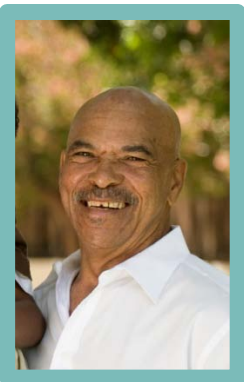
With PATH patients feel more confident about:
