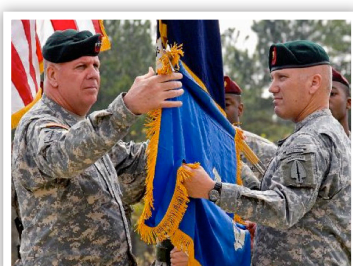


EDUCATION AND MOTIVATION PROGRAMS
