The John Wayne Airport hotel is centrally located in Irvine, CA, providing travelers with accommodations no more than 30 minutes away from major cities hosting Oktoberfest bashes, so revelers can party hop while spending minimal time on the road.

Oktoberfest runs through Oct. 6, 2013, in <u>Anaheim</u> and is held at the Phoenix Club. The venue boasts a large selection of German import beer on tap and is serving delicious roast pig on a spit. From 4-8:30 p.m. on Oct. 24, 2013, festivities will take place in <u>Fullerton's</u> Downtown Plaza. The venue is offering live entertainment, produce vendors, an outdoor beer garden, arts and crafts, kids' activities and more. Attendees will also be able to tour the award-winning Fullerton Museum Center with a reduced admission rate of \$2. Additionally, the first 500 children will receive trick or treat bags and get to trick or treat at vendors' booths throughout the festival. Children can also participate in a costume parade at either 5 p.m. or 6:45 p.m.

Oktoberfest is celebrated all day long throughout the month of October in Newport Beach at the <u>Balboa Bay Resort</u>. The property's First Cabin Restaurant and Duke's Place feature lunch and dinner specials inspired by German dishes and include a large variety of beers. Diners will be able to sample dishes like wienerschnitzel, sauerbraten, Bayarian bratwurst and warm apple strudel.

Wednesdays and Thursdays the festival offers free admission, beer tasting, food trucks and live German bands. Visitors under 21 must be accompanied by their parents. Fridays and Saturdays the festival is only open to party-goers 21 and older and admission is \$20. Sundays are family friendly, adult admission is \$5, child admission is \$2 and kids under five party for free. In addition to food and kids' activities, there will also be wiener dog races.

With so much going on during the month of October in Orange County, vacationers will appreciate the central location of the Courtyard Irvine John Wayne Airport, enabling them to see and attend as many festivals as they wish.
