- C treble clef

- Master rhythm part melody, bass (Utilitarian C part)
- Piano 1 emphasizing melody
- · Piano 2 emphasizing chordal/comping
- · Keys auxiliary parts for strings, organ or synth (not on all scores)
- · Vibes 1 emphasizing melody
- · Vibes 2 emphasizing chordal/comping

Guitar (w/ chords & TAB)

- 1 Treble clef melody
- 2 Treble clef chordal/comping
- 3 Treble clef rhythmic part

Bass (w/ chords)

- Bass clef full part
- · Bass clef partial/sketch part for more advanced players

Drums/Percussion

- Full drum part
- 3 Percussion parts for all songs
