



By the numbers ...

23,200,000: The number of dollars awarded for ACGT endeavors. Of that, \$11.3 million has gone toward discovery and research, and \$11.9 million has gone toward translation into treatments.

100: The percent of donations that go directly toward research endeavors. Funding for administrative and fundraising costs is provided separately.

17: The number of funded research projects that have been approved for human clinical trials; 11 trials have started. These trials provide scientists and patients with the opportunity to put research into practice – and save lives.

3: The number of ACGT award-winning doctors and research fellows presenting on this evening's panel. Carl H. June M.D. with the University of Pennsylvania, Laurence Cooper M.D., Ph.D. with the MD Anderson Cancer Center, and Michel Sadelain M.D., Ph.D. with the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, will discuss recent breakthroughs and advances in the field of cell and gene therapies.

1: the number of charitable organizations in the nation dedicated exclusively to cell and gene-based therapies for cancer.
