ane Chu serves as the president and CEO for the Kauffman Center for the Performing Arts, located at 16th and Broadway in Kansas City, which is the performance home of the Kansas City Ballet, Kansas City Symphony, and Lyric Opera of Kansas City, and houses community presentations from contemporary dance, Broadway, children's theatre, and national and international artists. Since its grand opening in September 2011, more than 750,000 people have already attended an event at the center.

Jane holds bachelors and masters degrees in piano performance, music education and piano pedagogy from Ouachita Baptist University and Southern Methodist University, respectively. Additionally, Jane holds a master of business administration from Rockhurst University, a PhD in philanthropic studies at Indiana University, and holds an Honorary Doctorate (Honoris causa) in music from the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music and Dance
