Any farmer or rancher age 40 and under who receives at least half of his or her income from farming and farm-related ventures may apply.

To apply, complete the entry form and essay questions and send a letter of reference from an accountant, banker, input dealer/representative or agribusiness leader. Winners agree to be recognized in articles potential print, broadcast and online media. Any financial information remains confidential unless entrants agree to its release.
