Product Background	Dynamics SL, originally called Solomon IV for Windows, was created by Solomon Software. In April 1999, Solomon Software refocused the product on an all Microsoft technology strategy. Microsoft SQL Server as the database technology, Visual Basic as the software language and Visual Basic for Applications (VBA) as the customization language. Solomon was acquired by Microsoft in 2001 as part of the acquisition of Great Plains Software. Today Dynamics SL finds its niche in companies interested in using its strong Project Accounting capabilities, including the Construction, Mining, Legal and Professional Services industries. It has approximately 14,000 companies using it in the United States.	Dynamics GP (formerly Great Plains) started as a DOS-based accounting system in the 1980's, moved to a Windows-based system in the early 1990's and was acquired by Microsoft in 2001. Dynamics GP is a complete and scalable business management solution that helps small growing and midsize organizations get up and running quickly. Dynamics GP integrates with industry-standard technologies, such as Microsoft Office, Microsoft Lync, Microsoft BizTalk Server, Component Object Model (COM), the Microsoft .NET Framework, Microsoft Message Queuing (MSMQ), Web services and XML. Dynamics GP offers a vast ecosystem of ancillary solutions thru Microsoft's Certified for Dynamics program. These solutions enable Dynamics GP to fit and scale an extensive array of different businesses and business models including Manufacturing, Distribution, Retail, Non-Profit and Professional Services as well as many smaller markets. Dynamics GP also has the largest number of customer in the US of any of the Dynamics ERP solutions with approximately 50,000 organizations using the solution.	Dynamics NAV (formerly Navision) was created through the merger of Navision Software and Damgaard in December 2000, and acquired in 2002 by Microsoft. Dynamics NAV is a business management solution for small and mid-sized organizations. Dynamics NAV integrates with Microsoft products such as SQL Server, BizTalk Server, Exchange, Office, and Windows. Dynamics NAV most commonly finds it's fit with organizations looking for a highly custom solution designed to meet unique and special business needs. It fits very well with companies who are operating in multiple countries with multiple locations. NAV offers an extensive development toolkit which enables the rapid development of the customized solution. NAV has approximately 14,000 organizations using it in the United States	Dynamics AX (formerly Axapta) was created through the merger of Navision Software and Damgaard in December 2000, and acquired in 2002 by Microsoft. Dynamics AX is multi-language, multi-currency enterprise resource planning (ERP) solution for growing or mid-sized and larger companies. Dynamics AX natively supports the breadth of Microsoft products such as SQL Server, BizTalk Server, Exchange, Office, CRM and Lync; Dynamics AX was designed with one database, one toolbox, one business logic, and one source code. Highly customizable and upgradable unlike many Tier 1 ERP solutions, it is also supported by a large and growing number of Certified for Microsoft Dynamics solutions. AX has strong features in Manufacturing, Retail, Distribution and Public Sector. Dynamics AX is used by approximately 16,000 companies in the U.S. Dynamics AX is the only Microsoft ERP solution which can be purchased thru Microsoft's Enterprise Agreements from a licensed Microsoft Large Account Reseller (LAR).
