THE DIRECTOR

Down and Dangerous is the second feature film written and directed by **multipleaward winning filmmaker Zak Forsman** (*Heart of Now*). Asked about his inspiration:

"From 1970 to 1972, my father had a brief career in the cocaine trade as an independent smuggler that was documented in the New York Times best-seller, Snowblind. The creative methods he used to pull off a dozen scams from South America were so ingenious that the person carrying the load always had a way out – they could walk away free and clear if the cocaine was discovered at Customs. He was uniquely principled for this line of work and always put people first. While Down and Dangerous is in no way related to Snowblind and is not an adaptation, it's his adventures and life lessons that served as my creative spark behind this new movie. It's certainly no coincidence that the acronym for Down and Dangerous is DAD."
