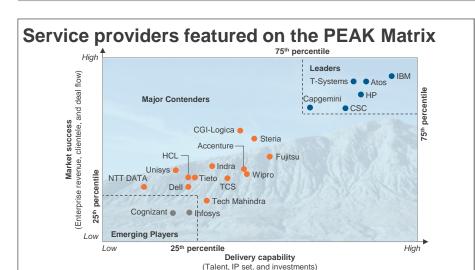
- Overall infrastructure service market of ~US\$50 billion. The growth has stagnated and will be muted in years to come. Service providers need to take market share away from others to grow
- Europe continues to provide over one third of global infrastructure service engagements. Increasing adoption of "offshore-centric" engagements

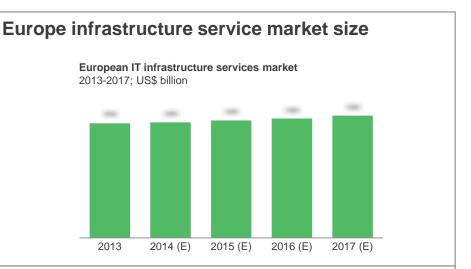
