All of the resident apartments underwent a complete makeover. “We completely transformed the resident apartments,” says Wendy Wood, Executive Director of Avamere Living at Berry Park. “New carpet, new paint, new cabinets, new vinyl. We replaced doors, molding and trim were switched out; and so many other upgrades.”

The staff and residents of Avamere Living at Berry Park are excited to open their doors to the public. “Avamere is certainly proud of re-invigorating this property that has served the residents of Oregon City and surrounding communities for so long,” says Wood. “But it is so wonderful to hear from residents about how proud and excited they are to bring friends and families to see their new home and enjoy all of the great additions and upgrades we’ve made.”
