



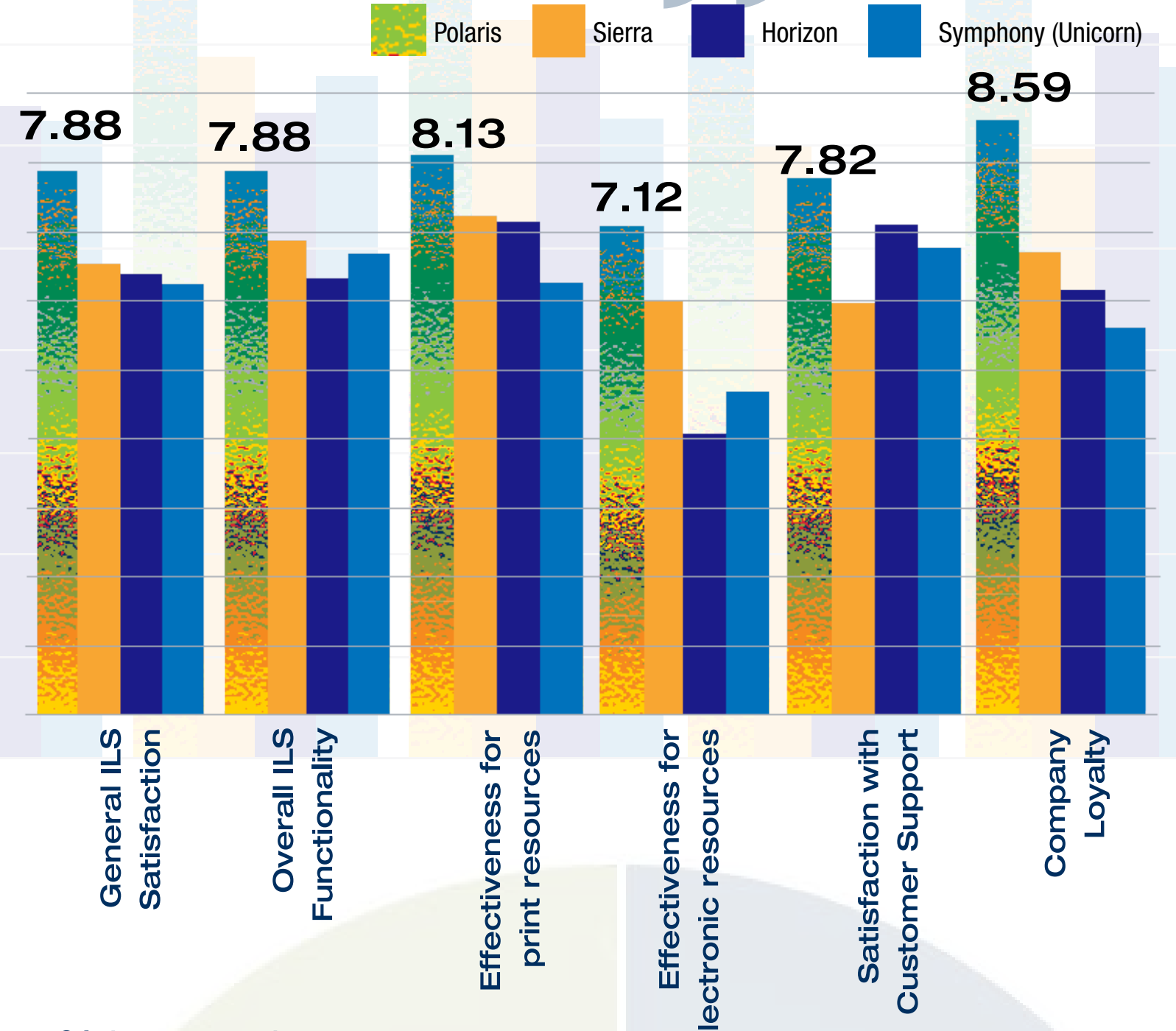

2013 PERCEPTIONS SURVEY

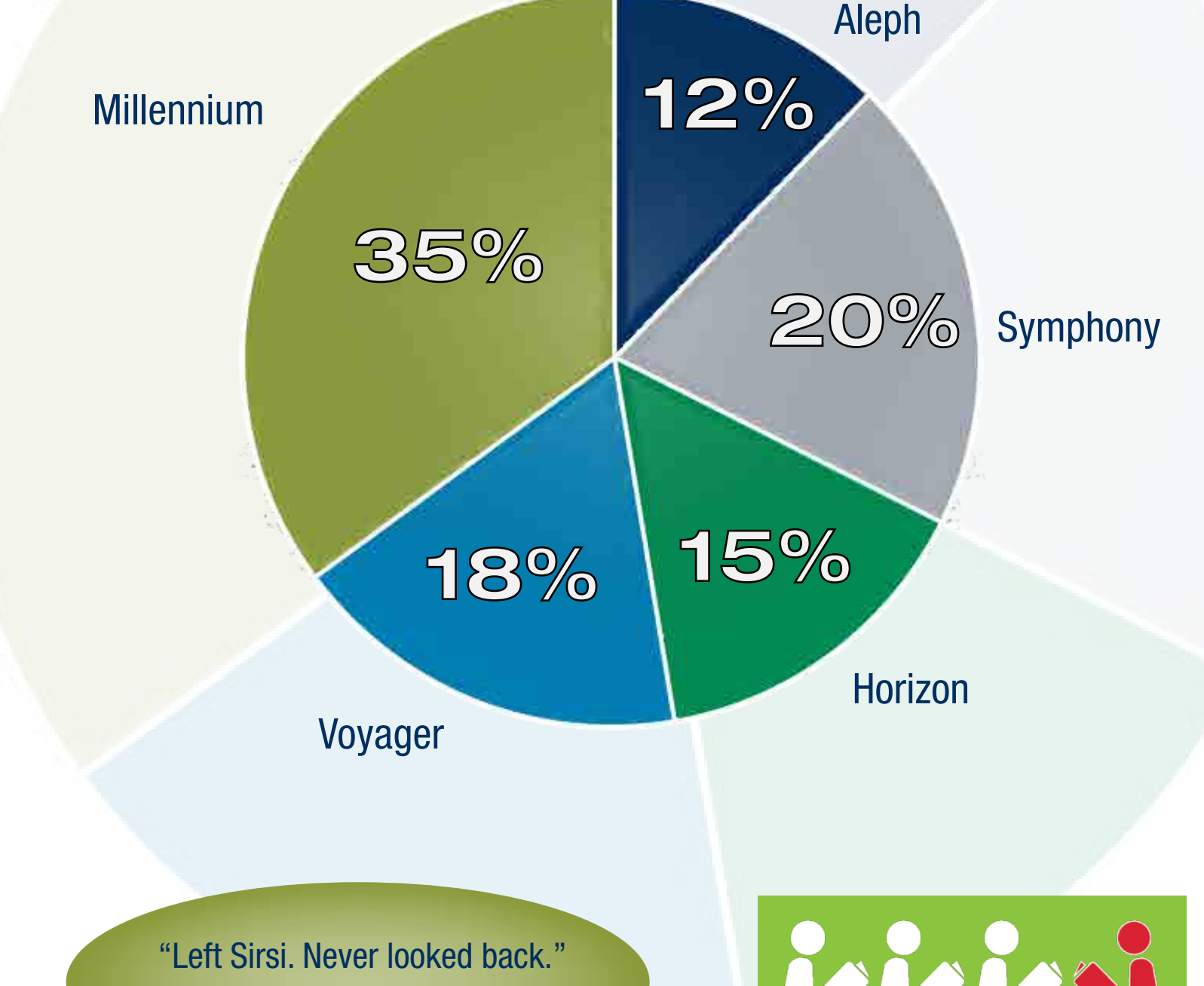

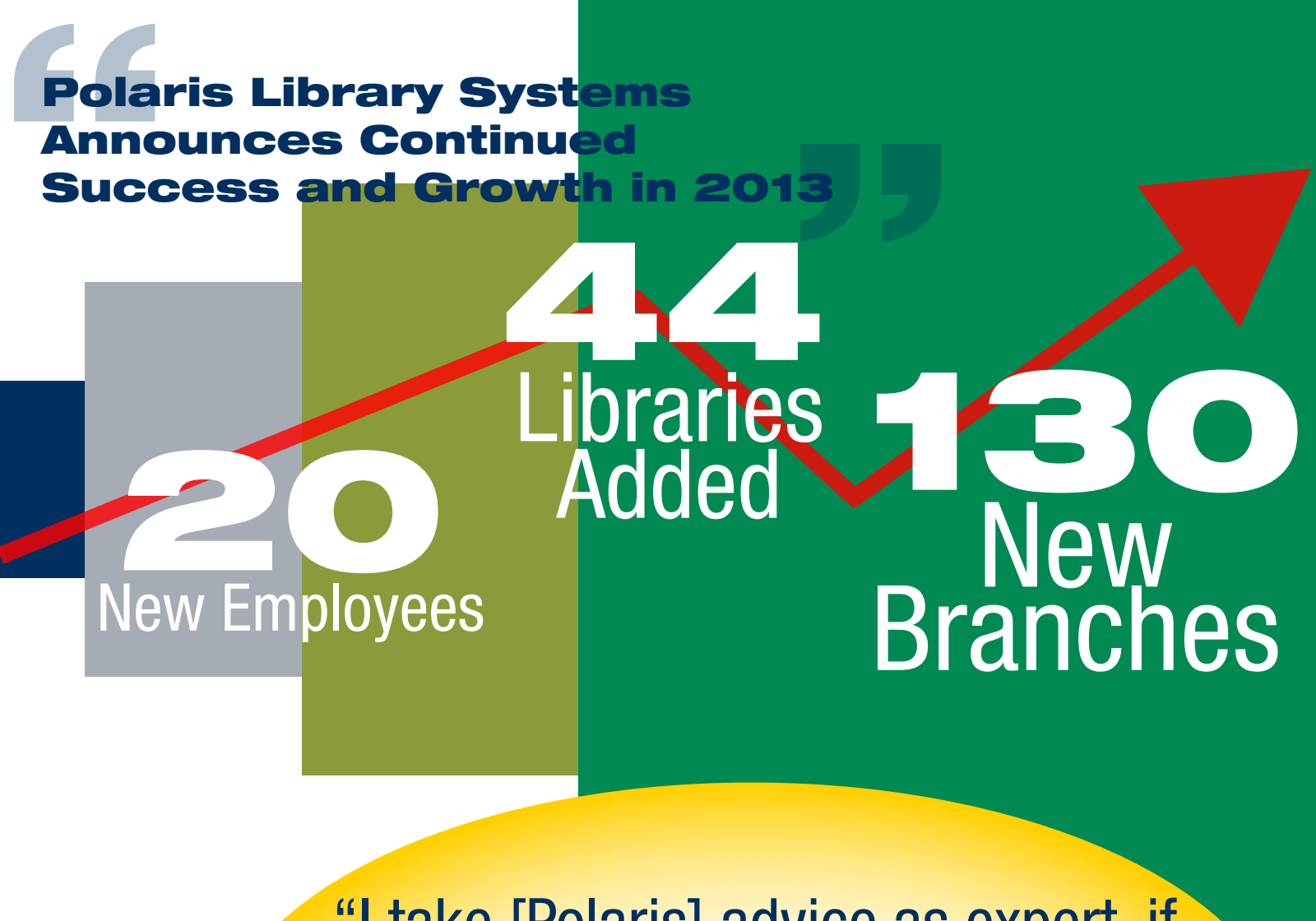
