Groundbreaking Ceremony Held for Grapevine Community Activities Center

(Richardson, Texas) March 7, 2014 – On Friday morning, March 7, a ground breaking ceremony marked the official start of the new Community Activities Center (CAC) in Grapevine, TX. The expanded recreation and aquatics center will be a valuable asset to the citizens of Grapevine, TX.
