

Farmington Meadows

Farmington Meadows was built in 1982 as fully subsidized Section 8 HUD housing located in Aloha, Oregon. The community consists of 69 one, two, and three bedroom homes, a playground, and garden area for resident use. The resident population is 70% senior, 30% families.



Without rental subsidies, the average rent at Farmington Meadows would have increased by 320%, effectively pricing residents out of their home.


