This success on the field does not come at the expense of off the field. The concept of 'Education Through Soccer' is something that has proven to be extremely important to the young women who play for our club. Life after soccer means getting a good education and a fulfilling life. Colleges and employers seek former athletes because they possess the skills companies want – teamwork, analytical thinking, competitiveness and drive.
