



CanAm Veterans Challenge

Capital to Capital with Injured Veterans
June 20 – July 4, 2014

The **2014 CanAm Veterans Challenge** from national non-profit World T.E.A.M. Sports provides an exceptional opportunity for injured veterans from the United States and Canada to ride together on bicycles, hand cycles and recumbent bicycles from national capital to national capital. Presented by Realty Capital Securities LLC in collaboration with Wounded Warriors Canada and Soldier On, the riders will travel from Ottawa, Ontario, 40 to 110 miles per day. They will pass through several cities and communities on route to Washington, arriving on July 4, America's Independence Day. Along the two-week route, the veterans will ride through farmlands and forests, suburban and urban communities large and small, and will meet Americans from both sides of the border.

Since 1993, World T.E.A.M. Sports has created inclusive sporting events for disabled and able-bodied participants. For the **CanAm Veterans Challenge**, ten veteran riders with disabilities from Canada will join ten American Armed Forces riders for the 662 mile journey through three states, one province and the District of Columbia. A small number of able-bodied riders will join the team for the full ride, with a larger number of day riders riding a few hours.

During the ride, the team will stop in local parks and restaurants for meals, and will join with disabled communities along the way for receptions. Corporate sponsors have the opportunity to create special events, sponsor meals and create media opportunities during the full two weeks of the ride.
